Creative Arts Workshop

Carpentry for Kids

Students will learn to use a complement of hand tools during a course that emphasizes safe tool use, practical problem solving and creative development. Projects increase in difficulty as experience grows.

Woodworking students will begin with projects such as a small toy boat and work up to full-sized furniture and professional skateboards.

All first-time carpentry students **MUST** attend the first day of class to safely participate in the course. No exceptions. Advanced projects may require an additional materials fee.
