ABOUT US.

The Junior Center of Art and Science encourages children's natural wonder and innovation through **creative exploration** in the arts and sciences. We do so through hands-on activities, inquiry led discussion, and collaborative play. With the Junior Center, students will find a warm, inclusive space that provides skill building in experimentation, problem-solving, and innovation with practicing artists and scientists.

We are proud to have served Oakland and the greater East Bay for over 60 years. Each year, we reach over 10,000 students from the ages of 2 to 17 years old.

EXHIBITIONS & SCHOOL TOURS

The Junior Center offers fun and engaging field trip opportunities through our school tour program. Students experience a guided tour of work on display in our gallery, engage in inquiry-led group discussion, then participate in a hands-on making activity led by one of our instructors.

Our tours support Common Core State Standards by encouraging critical thinking, communication, creativity and collaboration by looking at, talking about, and making original works of art.

SCHOOL RESIDENCIES

We offer artist-in-residence and STEAM programs both inschool and after school. We also offer professional development programs for teachers and parents.

Our programs are custom designed to the meet the unique and individual needs of each school partner.

During a typical residency, our instructors visit a classroom once a week for up to 90-minutes. Jr. Center instructors work directly with teachers to integrate arts and science concepts into student learning and enhance the learning happening in other subject areas.

Each residency includes:

- + A planning meeting to define customized goals/objectives
- + Original curriculum designed for each program
- + Program supplies and educational materials
- + Hands-on activities for participants
- + Culminating presentation of participants' learning
