

Art Exploration (5 - 8 year olds)

The curriculum focuses on developing and expanding students' artistic skills through a series of age-appropriate lessons. Drawing and painting projects emphasize line, gesture, perspective, contour and composition. Sculpture projects build on these skills from a three-dimensional perspective. Materials include pencil, marker, watercolor, oil pastel, acrylic & tempera paint, and clay. This class is appropriate for new and continuing students.



Visual Arts (9+ year olds)

Students will focus on developing and expanding their artistic skills through a series of age-appropriate art lessons. Drawing and painting projects will emphasize line, gesture, proportion, perspective, contour, and composition. Sculpture projects will build on these skills from a 3D perspective.
